

ABOUT

Our Santa Barbara County Rosé is 100% Grenache from the Dairy Vineyard in Santa Ynez. Aged 6 months in stainless steel (90%) and neutral oak (10%), this wine has beautiful aromas of wild raspberry and watermelon with an enticingly soft and subtle palate.

VINTACE NOTES

2023 is looking to be one of the best vintages Santa Barbara County has ever seen. With an unusually cold and wet beginning to the year and a long, mild growing season that extended up to a full month behind our normal harvest timing, the grapes enjoyed extra hang time and the opportunity to develop gradually. This lead to grapes with beautiful concentration, balance, and vibrant acidity.
